General Responsibility

To develop and implement Jewish programming at camp. To provide a positive enriching Israeli culture identity and awareness to the campers/staff.

Specific Responsibilities

- Be available for 16 hours of remote pre-camp planning in May and June
- Assist in leading and participating in Staff Week June 17-21, 2024
- Attend J&R Day Camp Open House
- Oversee coordination and planning of weekly Shabbat experience, including coordinating Shabbat song session with music specialist and shlichim
- Collaborate with program coordinator to infuse middot into flagpole programming
- Collaborate with Shlichim with coordination and planning of Israel Day
- Oversee coordination and planning of Camp Kindness Day
- Implement Jewish values (Middot) curriculum into weekly camp rituals, all-camp/unit programming, group activities and specialty area
- Create Tikkun Olam program for 4th-8th grade campers that includes hands-on, meaningful service-learning opportunities throughout the summer
- Assist Unit Leaders with creating programs that include Jewish themes/content.
- Act as a resource to help integrate Jewish values and themes into camp program areas
- Assist in conducting initial and end-of-season inventory in program area.
- Set up program area during staff week
- Prepare lesson plans a week in advance and review with the Program Director to ensure materials needed are available, aspirational arcs are being set, and activities are age appropriate
- Implement creative weekly lesson plans by unit and age group that are infused with the Jewish value (middah) of the week
- Be responsible for daily opening and closing procedures in the program area
- Assist in shut down procedures and packing all materials and supplies at end of season.
- Must attend and plan for at least one after camp extra programming (late stay or overnight) additional compensation provided
- Attend daily leadership team meetings at 8:00am
- Prepare for and actively participate in staff trainings and meetings both before camp starts and ongoing throughout the summer
- Other duties as assigned
- Be a positive, contributing member of the Leadership Team



Additional Responsibilities

- Set a good example for campers including cleanliness, punctuality, sharing cleanup and chores, and sportsmanship.
- Follow camp rules and regulations
- Encourage respect for personal property, camp equipment and facilities.
- Manage personal time off in accordance with camp policy.
- Additional responsibilities as assigned

Compensation:

• \$4,500-\$5,000 depending on experience

Bonuses: In order to be eligible for any bonus you must work a minimum of 6 weeks

- \$700 bonus if you miss 10% of days or less of contracted time to work, age 18+
- \$250 All Star bonus
- \$250 bonus if you refer a friend to work at camp
- Bonuses will be awarded in final paycheck at the discretion of the camp director
