General Responsibility

To plan, direct, and supervise camp's media program including videography, photography, and all social media platforms and My Camp App.

Specific Responsibilities

- Be available for 6 hours of remote pre-camp planning in April and May
- Participate in Staff Week June 17-21, 2024
- Attend J&R Day Camp Open House
- Prepare for and actively participate in staff trainings and meetings
- Document camp life through video and photos including activity periods, regular activities, and special programs
- Produce end-of-summer video of camp highlights as well as a picture slideshow
- Create weekly videos during the camp season for distribution to all camp families
- Be responsible for planning and executing all video/media projects
- Learn how to use and post on My Camp App
- Post to social media and My Camp App at least 3 times a day
- Be responsible for the proper use of equipment and supplies
- Be a positive, contributing member of the specialist team

Additional Responsibilities

- Set a good example for campers including cleanliness, punctuality, sharing cleanup and chores, and sportsmanship
- Follow camp rules and regulations
- Encourage respect for personal property, camp equipment and facilities
- Manage personal time off in accordance with camp policy.
- Additional responsibilities as assigned

Compensation:

\$3,000 – \$4,500 depending on experience
